Project Objectives

To drastically halt and prevent HIV transmission & drug abuse so as to have a healthy, self-reliant and sustainable refugees and host communities in Nakivale refugee settlements, Isingiro district

Key actions

- Establish a Rehabilitation center
- Conduct Community awareness on Drug abuse prevention measure
- Conduct Community awareness on HIV prevention measures
- Conduct HIV Out reaches
- Organise a Sensitisation meeting of stakeholder's on HIV, STI & Drug abuse for UNHCR, religious leaders, community leaders, Police, Refugees Law, Head teachers, OPM, MTI, Windle Trust, DHO, CBO & MWOKHO Staff
- Promote Condom use by providing condoms and organising a strategic planning meeting of Community Condom Distributors
- Conduct a Stakeholder's review meeting
- Provide occupation; work (livelihood; Financial literacy, Entreprenuership & Vocational training), sports and promote access to education
- Conduct social mobilisation by using Refugees Welfare Councils
- Conduct Community awareness on Safe Medical Male Circumcision
- Organise a 2day's workshop in the concepts of HIV/AIDS & Drug abuse of community volunteers, CBO & MWOKHO Staff, VHTs, community leaders,

Religious leaders, community workers, school teachers.

- Establish a referral linkage between community and HIV/AIDS Clinics for services
- Organise Community sensitisation on Rape, prevention and referral for medical services
- Conduct Community sensitisation on STI, prevention and treatment
- Conduct Community sensitisation on early pregnancy, prevention and treatment
- Promote prevention of infectious diseases including COVID19 and Malaria in HIV/AIDS POSITIVE & NEGATIVE Persons in the community.

WASH PROJECT

Objective: To contribute towards increased access to water, sanitation and hygiene to obtain a healthy, self-reliant and sustainable refugees and host communities in Nakivale refugees settlement, Isingiro district

Priority actions

- Promote rain water harvesting at household, institution and community level
- Conduct Community sensitization on hygiene; personal, environmental & food hygiene including COVID19 Protocols.
- Conduct Community sensitization on sanitation; use of pit latrines for defeacation and Anal cleansing.
- Provision of Hand public hand washing stations to private schools
- Promotion of increase of latrine coverage in private schools, government schools, market places and car parks
- Provision of disinfectants, soap, liquid soap and sanitizers to private schools and saloons
- Promotion of Menstrual hygiene among females of reproductive health (12 to 49years)
- Conduct a Sensitisation meeting of stakeholders on WASH for UNHCR, Police, Nsamizi, Head

Teachers, Community leaders, OPM, Windle trust, DHO, Alight, DRC, CBO & MWOKHO Staff

- Conduct a 2day's Workshop on Hygiene for Saloon owners & workers
- Conduct a 2Day's workshop on Food Hygiene for Restaurant owners & workers
- Promote formation of associations for Saloons and restaurants
- Conduct training of Saloons and Restaurants associations on financial literacy and forming of saving and loan groups or schemes
- Establish a resolving fund to promote saving and loaning culture among women and youth with or to start small income generating activities.
- Promote social entrepreneurship among women and youth e.g soap making and briquette making e.t.c
- Promote environmental conservation such as tree planting, use of energy saving stoves, biogas and briquette making e.t.c
- Conduct Community sensitisation on environmental conservation.
- Carry out a 2day's workshop on training community volunteers, CBO, religious leaders, VHTs, Community workers, school teachers and MWOKHO Staff in the concepts of WASH.
- Conduct a Stakeholder's review meeting
- Facilitate good solid waste management by provision of equipment, PPE,Tricycle motorcycle and training of community voluteers and CBOs staff(Building Capacity of CBOs).
- Organise social mobilisation by using the Refugees Welfare Councils to handle the cleaning up operation of water bodies of solid waste
- Conduct Community sensitisation on solid waste management at individual, Household and community level using RWCs and IEC even community meetings.
- Carry out a Stakeholder's meeting on Promoting the access of persons with disabilities to WASH
 Facilities: UNHCR, Nsamizi, Alight, OPM, CBOs, RWC leaders, Religious leaders, Head teachers,
 Windle trust, and Market & Taxis parks chairmen
- Conduct vector control to prevent transmission of infectious diseases such as Malaria
