**OUR PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:**

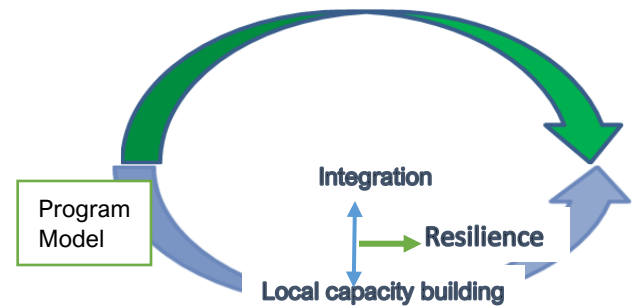
Our strategic objectives contribute to the realization of the overall goal, mission and vision of MWOK Humanitarian Organization:

- SO5:** Strengthening institutional and local community structures for sustainability

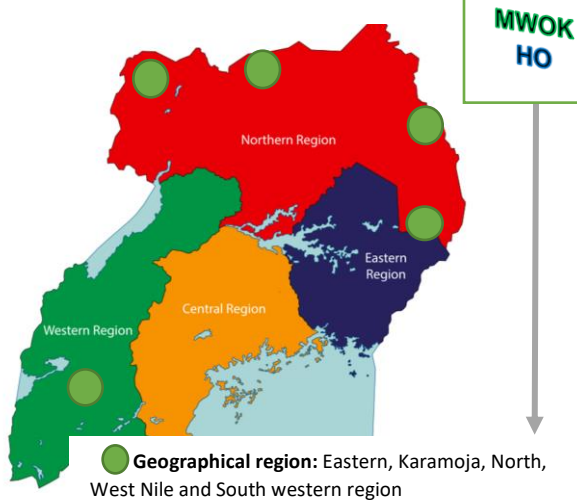
**OUR THERMATIC AREAS:**

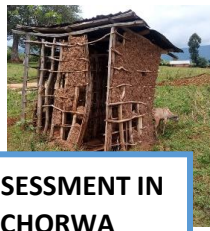

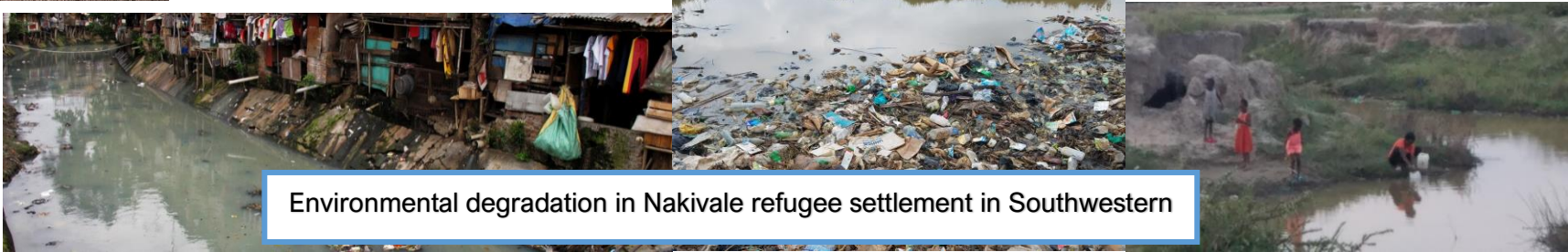
